8th Course on Military Medical Ethics in Times of Armed Conflict (MME)

Mandated by the International Committee of Military Medicine (ICMM) Organized by the Swiss Armed Forces Medical Services Directorate from the 31th of August to the 4rd of September 2020 in virtual conference

Since 1999, Switzerland has the honour to organize the course on International Law of Armed Conflict (LOAC). Furthermore, a course on Military Medical Ethics (MME) is being offered in parallel since 2012. The International Committee for Military Medicine (ICMM) has mandated Switzerland to host these important courses with the aim to familiarize officers in the medical services of the armed forces with the rules and principles of LOAC and MME.

Due to the travel restrictions imposed by the response to COVID-19 by many countries, we unfortunately cannot organize the 2020 course in Spiez / Switzerland as usual. We decided to see the current situation as an opportunity to explore a new format of the course though and to organize the course as a "virtual classroom course". Thus, the 8th ICMM Course on Military Medical Ethics in Times of Armed Conflict (Military Medical Ethics/ MME) will take place from 31 August – 04 September 2020 in video conference.

We have the pleasure to invite military medical personnel, military medico-legal officers and chaplains as well as other personnel from military medical services to our courses. The course is politically and denominationally neutral and is open to all ICMM member states, the EAPC/PfP partner states as well as the MD-states.
